CASE GRANT EDUCATION AWARD

Michigan Campus Compact is sponsoring a \$1000 grant opportunity for students to establish or significantly further a partnership between the students (and their school) and a community nonprofit organization.

Students must propose an innovative academic service-learning project, recruit a community organization as a partner, and have a faculty member agree to advise the project. Winners agree to keep a running account of project activities and write a project summary report at the conclusion of the project. Students may also create a supplemental documentary of the project via video (such as on YouTube) or PowerPoint for publication.
