<b>Jane Kessler</b>	12/15/2008	In my psych courses, I teach about the effects of environmental variables on mental health.

FCS students are urged to select a topic relating to personal or community resources. They systematically plan an action research project related to personal or community resources, implement it and then report on the changes that took place.
