Film Industry Training Offered at Madonna University

What: Madonna University will offer two non-credit courses this November for those who would like to work in the film industry as a voice-over actor or production assistant (P.A.).

During the *Advanced Voice-over* course, Denver voice coach Tia Marlier will help students hone their vocal skills, find their “money voice,” develop employment strategies, learn how to market themselves and how to acquire an agent. Tuition for the three-day class is \$99.

Film Basics – Working on Film Sets will provide students with a comprehensive overview of the P.A.’s role. Topics covered include: set etiquette, the roles of other set workers, and how to utilize P.A. unions, trade organizations and nonprofits. The class will meet on two consecutive Saturdays and costs \$105, including the textbook.
