Madonna University Proposal and Grant Workshop at Macomb University Center

What: This five-week class covers the basic skills needed to prepare a successful grant proposal when seeking funding for a nonprofit organization. Offered by Madonna University, “Proposal Writing & Grant Administration” begins Friday, May 29, at the University Center at Macomb Community College.

Instructor Sharon Miller, J.D., M.A., will cover the following topics: generating program ideas, researching funding sources, formatting a basic proposal, and understanding the politics of grants. Guest speakers will attend the workshop to share examples of successful proposals. Miller served as CEO of the nonprofit Wayne Mediation Center from 1990 to 2004, generating over two million dollars from government and private funding sources.
