Madonna University at Macomb Information Nights March 29, April 14

What: Macomb-area students can discover how to earn a Madonna University bachelor's degree in one of three programs – emergency management, criminal justice and hospitality management – without ever leaving Macomb County.

During an information night at the University Center at Macomb Community College, students will have an opportunity to meet the Madonna program director, receive academic advising, find out about credit for prior learning, apply for admission (fee waived), learn about financial aid, and register for spring/summer and fall classes.
