Free Behavioral Assessments for Children at Madonna University's Psychology Clinic

LIVONIA, Mich. — Families with children ages six-16 can take advantage of free behavioral testing offered at Madonna University's Psychology Clinic, located at 36600 Schoolcraft Road, in Livonia. The comprehensive assessments, suitable for children experiencing a wide-range of behavioral, emotional or academic concerns, are performed by advanced graduate students in Madonna's clinical psychology program, under the close supervision of experienced, licensed psychologists.

“The tests conducted at Madonna are far more extensive than those offered through the public schools,” said Clinic Director Jane Kessler. “They typically are not covered by health insurance and can cost over \$1,400 when administered by a private psychologist.”

Openings for the free behavioral assessments are very limited and will be filled on a first-come, first-serve basis. The child must attend with a legal guardian, who will receive detailed feedback, recommendations and a comprehensive written report. For 7 years, Madonna University's Psychology Clinic has offered low-cost psychological testing, assessment and treatment for a broad spectrum of mental and emotional challenges including anxiety, depression, stress management, relationship and marital problems, and other outpatient mental health situations. Afternoon, evening and weekend appointments are available year-round in confidential individual, couple or family settings. Costs for the Clinic's services range from \$10-\$60 per visit, depending on household income, and insurance is not needed.
