Registration for Madonna University Spring/Summer Courses Open Through May 7 *Aging and Older Adults Gerontology Certificate Offered*

What: Students of all ages can pursue their educational goals this spring and summer – be it working toward a degree, increasing job credentials with a course or certificate, or taking a class for fun. Registration for Madonna University spring/summer courses is open until Thursday, May 7. Classes begin Monday, May 4.

Classes are available in more than 70 undergraduate and 27 graduate programs, and they meet days, evenings, weekends and online.
